REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMATTING ABSTRACTS

- up to 2 pages of A 4 (210-297); do not number the pages;
- fonts: Times New Roman, 14, style Normal, 1-spaced; margins 2 cm all;
- any other fonts are provided additionally;
- the first line includes the title which must be typed in CAPITAL LETTERS and centred;
- the second line is author's surname and initials (bold, right-aligned);
- the third line is the name of the affiliation (italics, right-aligned);
- electronic version of the application form and abstract must be renamed with the author's name (e.g. Shilo_Ostap);
- the main text is followed by the list of literature. The word LITERATURE must be typed in CAPITAL LETTERS left-aligned;
- all in-text citations and a reference list must be done in APA Style.
